- You may paint with either regular oils or with water-soluble oils.
- Bring at least six photographs from which you'd like to paint. Select uncomplicated compositions with large shapes and good light-shadow contrasts (not expansive scenes such as the Grand Canyon). In addition to color photos, make a black and white copy of each (these will be valuable for identifying values).
- Have at least six 8x10s canvases for the four sessions.
- Paints: Bring any and all oil colors you wish to use. But be sure to have at least one tube each of a blue, yellow and red, plus white. The smaller 37ml tubes will be sufficient; but a large tube of either Titanium White or Permalba White will be best (150 ml).
- Brushes: Long-handled brushes specified for oil painting. Two brushes will do to begin:
 - #6 Flat (Or Filbert)
 - #3 Flat or #4 (Or Filbert)
- One to three Palette Knives of different sizes. (Metal blade, not plastic).
- If using standard oil paints, have an odorless Thinner: Either Gamsol, Turpenoid, or Turpenoid Natural. (Note: used mineral spirits cannot be disposed of at TLCA. You will need to take them with you after each class).
- Two sealed containers (e.g. jar and cap) for use with thinner to clean brushes and to thin paints.
- A palette. (glass or wood are best; do not use a paper palette).
- A watercolor pencil (in a light blue, or light green to be used to layout scenes on canvas prior to painting).
- Facial tissue or roll of paper towels. A bag to hold your used tissues or paper towels.
- A window glass scraper (to clean paint off the palette).
- A color wheel.
- A value gray-scale.
- A drawing pad (which come in titles such as: acrylic, watercolor, canvas)>
- A table-style easel .

Tables and chairs will be provided, but please bring a plastic sheet to cover the table.
